



# OAKEY STATE HIGH SCHOOL BYOX PROGRAM

In 2024, Oakey State High School will be running a 1-1 Bring Your Own Device (BYOx) program for ALL students in ALL year levels. Students will need to attend school with their device every day.

## BYOx Program Highlights

- Students in the program are required to bring their own laptop to school every day fully charged.
- BYOx will enhance student performance, enhance teaching and learning, and improve data literacy skills.
- The minimum required specification (see below) is about technical specifications not brands or models.
- Students, parents, or carers are required to sign the BYOx Charter Agreement (see website) regarding how the device can be used at school. When signed, you have agreed that your child brings their own device to school every day. This is also signed by parents at enrolment.
- The OSHS IT Technician is available to assist and answer technical questions.
- School does not manage, support, own, or guarantee the device. This remains the responsibility of families.
- Student owned devices connect to the school network via the 'BYOD Solution' which provides students with secure login to the network enabling access to in-school digital resources and the internet, protected by Education Queensland's filtering and reporting systems.
- If you are having financial difficulties, please contact the school in Term 4 to have a conversation about options.
- QLearn, Office365, and other educational online platforms are used in classes. These platforms have a personal workspace for every student, a content library for their handouts and a collaboration space for lessons and creative activities.

## I have my device, what now?
